The Tigray Data Repository (TDR) is an online, open-source repository that documents Tigray's history and the experiences of Tigrayan communities in Tigray and the Diaspora. The TDR, which was established in May 2024 and went live in April 2025, is a digital archive of the life, struggles, and experiences of Tigrayans. The repository documents various datasets that provide an overview of the Tigrayan community and their experiences. From digital, humanitarian, and socio-economic aspects to cultural, political, and educational experiences, the TDR captures every facet of the Tigrayan lifestyle— providing us with a general database for Tigray.

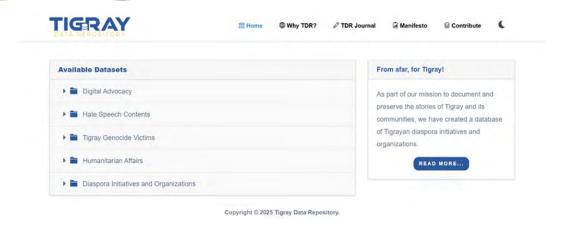

# Why TDR?

The Tigray Data Repository is more than just a hosting site. The TDR serves as:

- ◆ **A Bridge Between Generations**: TDR preserves Tigray's history through data, ensuring that its stories remain accessible to future generations.
- ◆ **A Tool for Advocacy and Research:** TDR contributes to advocacy, education, policymaking, and disaster response by collecting and analyzing data about the Tigrayan communities, locally and in the Diaspora.
- ◆ An accountability Tool: During the Tigray war, TDR documented the hate speech, disinformation campaigns, and dehumanizing narratives that targeted Tigrayans. Our records provide transparency for international justice investigations and accountability mechanisms.
- ◆ TDR's Data Analysis Journal: The TDR journal is committed to connecting Tigray with the global community by disseminating research findings from our extensive datasets. We are an essential platform for publishing special issues, with each publication highlighting the data we have meticulously archived in our repository.



Our aspiration, as outlined in our motto: "Data for Tigray, Knowledge for Generations!" is to create a long-lasting impact by sharing knowledge and collaborating for insights.

#### **Scope and Focus: Preserving Tigray's History and Practices**

The scope of TDR encompasses a broad range of data documenting various aspects of the Tigrayan communities, such as their digital, humanitarian, socio-economic, cultural, and historical progress. Consequently, we highlight significant events such as the wars and genocides faced by the people of Tigray, archiving the complex interplay between war crimes and the community's struggle for social justice. Thus, by recognizing Tigray's vast history, including positive and traumatic experiences, our repository aims to ensure comprehensive coverage and impactful documentation of Tigray's evolution.

**Project Focus**: For the initial phase, we will focus our data collection on the digital advocacy efforts of Tigrayan communities living in the Diaspora from November 2020 to November 2022, as well as on humanitarian affairs. We will also develop guidelines and standards for creating a complete profile of the victims of the Tigray Genocide, using the Axum Massacre as a case study. Over time, we plan on expanding our database from sectors such as education, agriculture, healthcare, and tourism to more categories. We plan to collaborate with the community, government and non-government agencies, and other committed individuals to record accurate data and make it accessible to the people.

**Tigrayan Diaspora Experience**: For the longest time, the Tigrayan communities in the Diaspora have played a significant role in international advocacy and in supporting the rebuilding efforts of the people of Tigray. As such, a key part of TDR's mission is to examine earlier historical periods, including the Diaspora's response to the war in Tigray during the Derg regime (1974-1991) and its effects. While our main focus will be on the recent advocacy efforts of the Diaspora communities, this historical perspective is crucial for understanding the broader context of their contributions. The interventions and efforts played by the Diaspora communities on various stages are a testimony to their devotion and resilience to creating a better Tigray.
